As the CoE puts it Jisomee, Jiamulie, Jichagulie! Petitioning the PSC! The Parliamentary Select Committee retreated to Naivasha, at the Great Rift Valley Lodge to build consensus on the Draft Constitution presented to them by the CoE. The PSC is mandated by the Constitution of Kenya Review Law to build consensus among parliamentarians on issues of contention. However, media reports coming out of the retreat intimated that the MPs were discussing issues out of their mandates as provided by law as such reversing gains made in the revised draft. It is with this information that the Katiba Sasa! Campaign mobilized for resources and headed to Naivasha to present a petition to the PSC in order that achievements so far made in the draft could be safe-guarded. The petition was presented on 22nd January 2010 with the participation of about 40 of the civil society representation despite the fact that the larger group was not allowed to enter the premises.
